

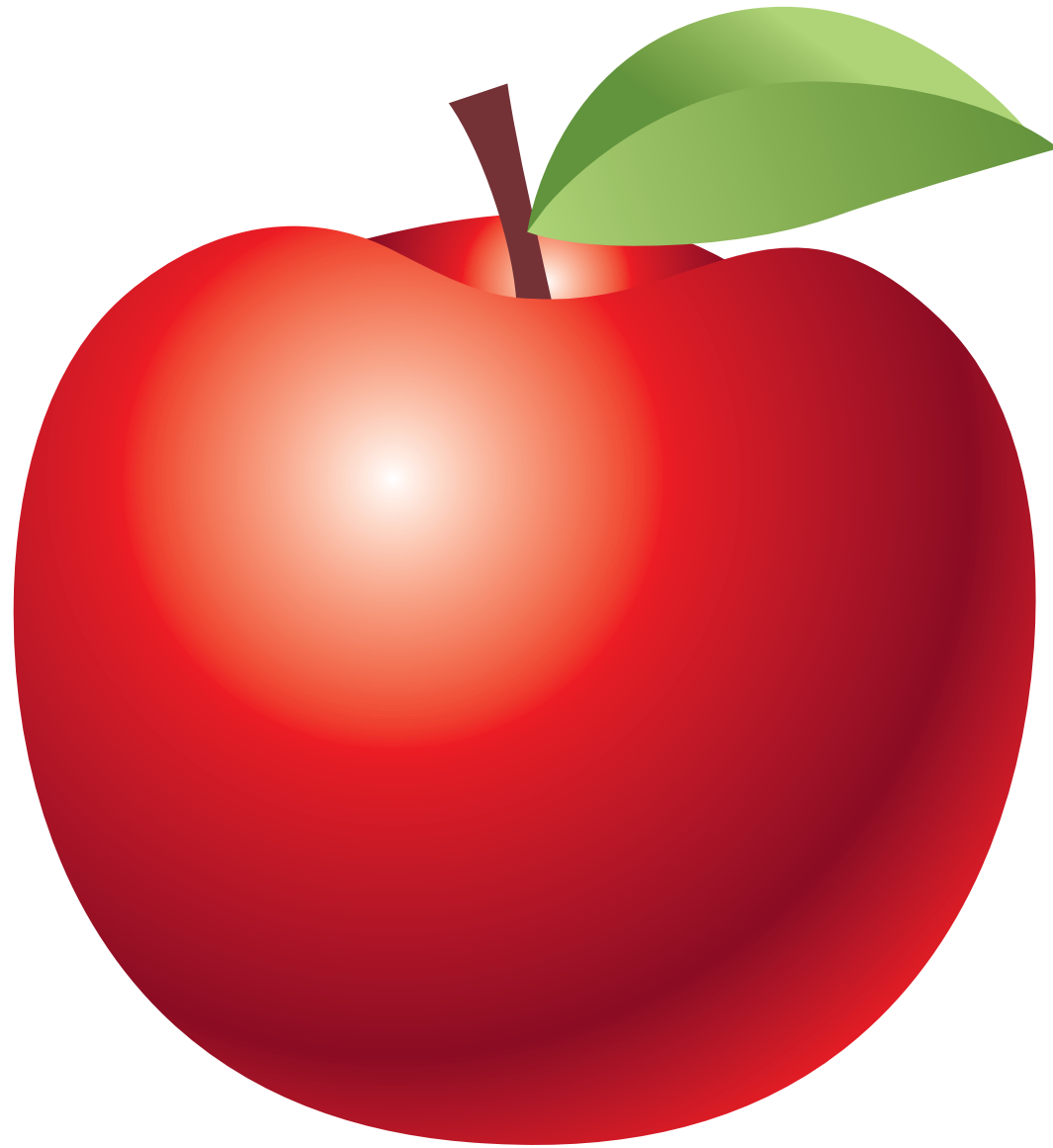

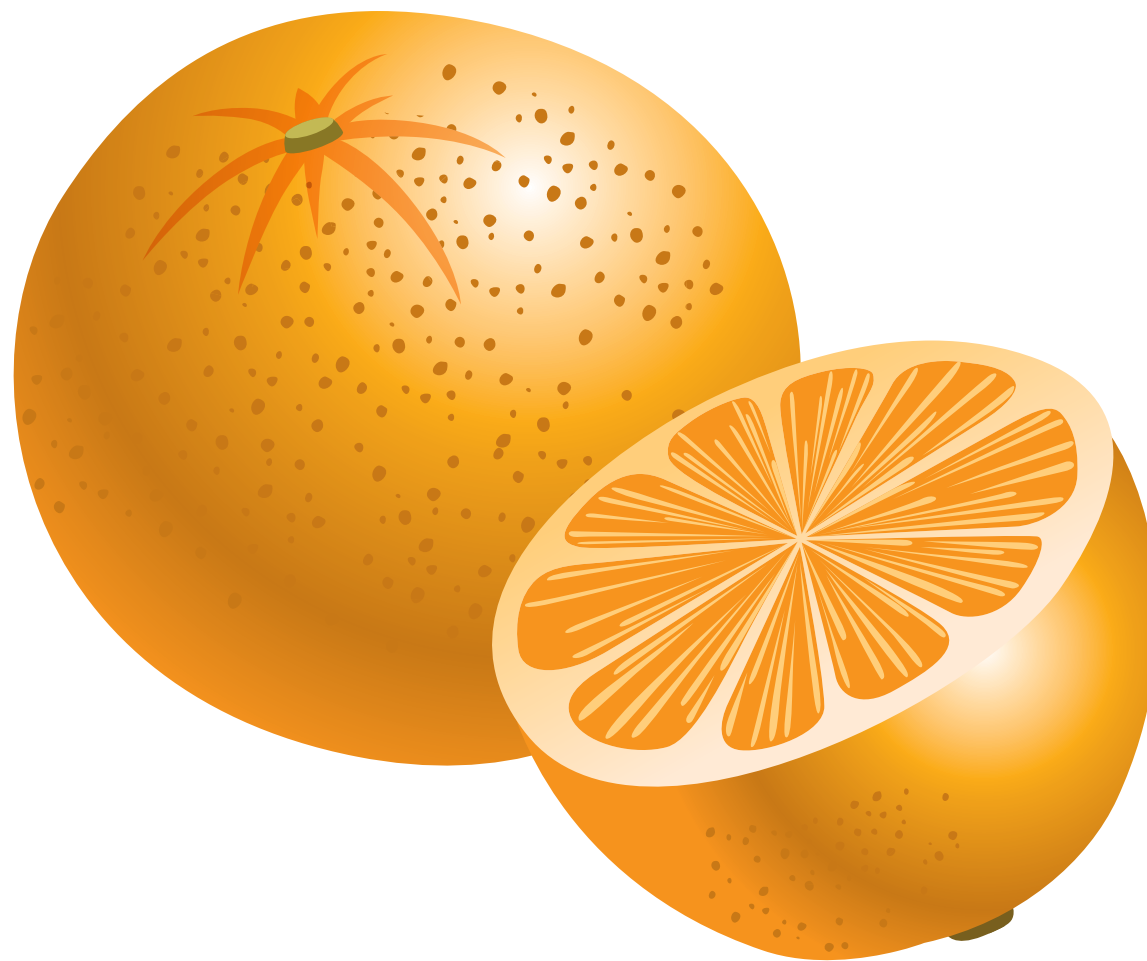

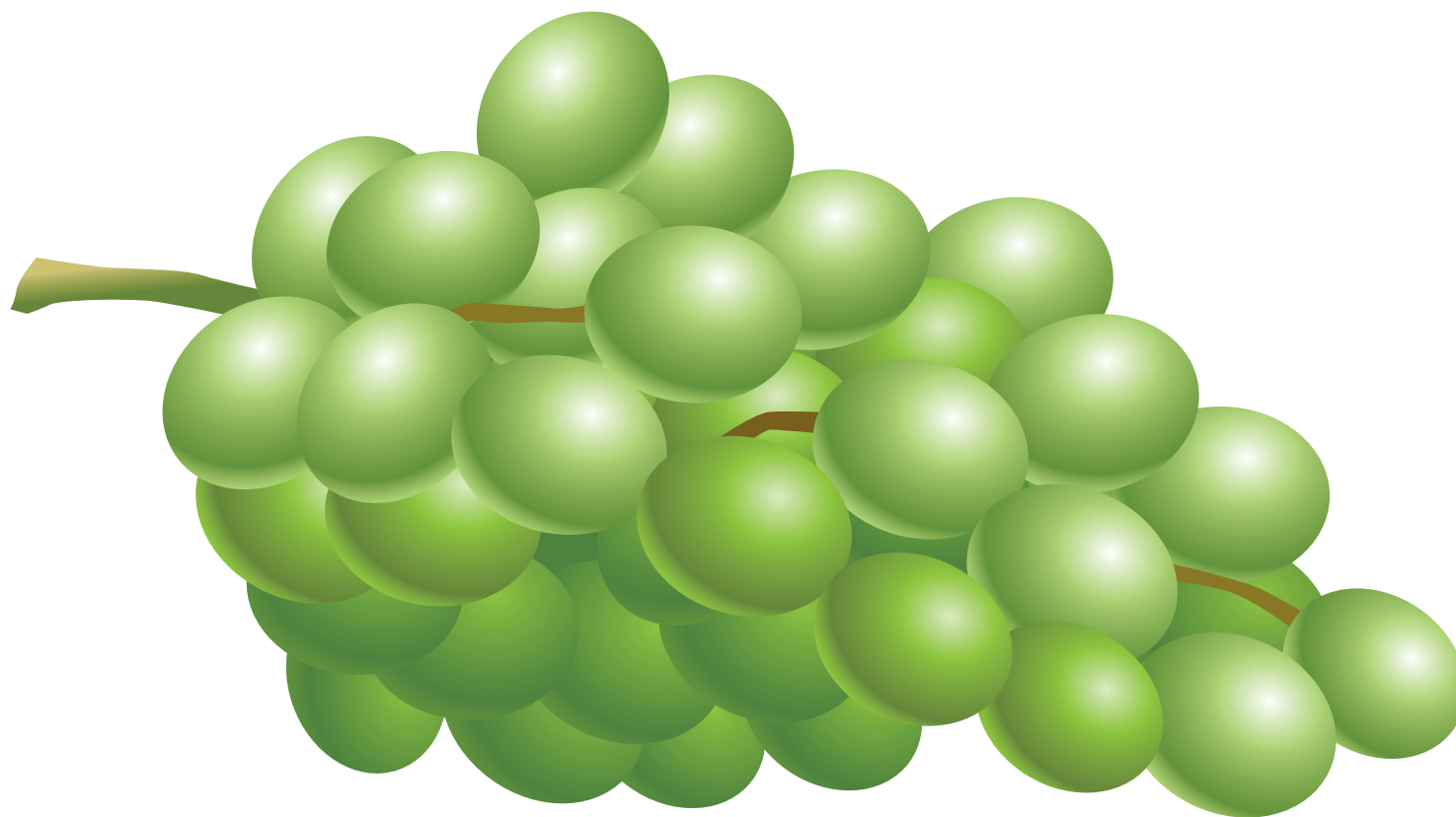
The apple is red.



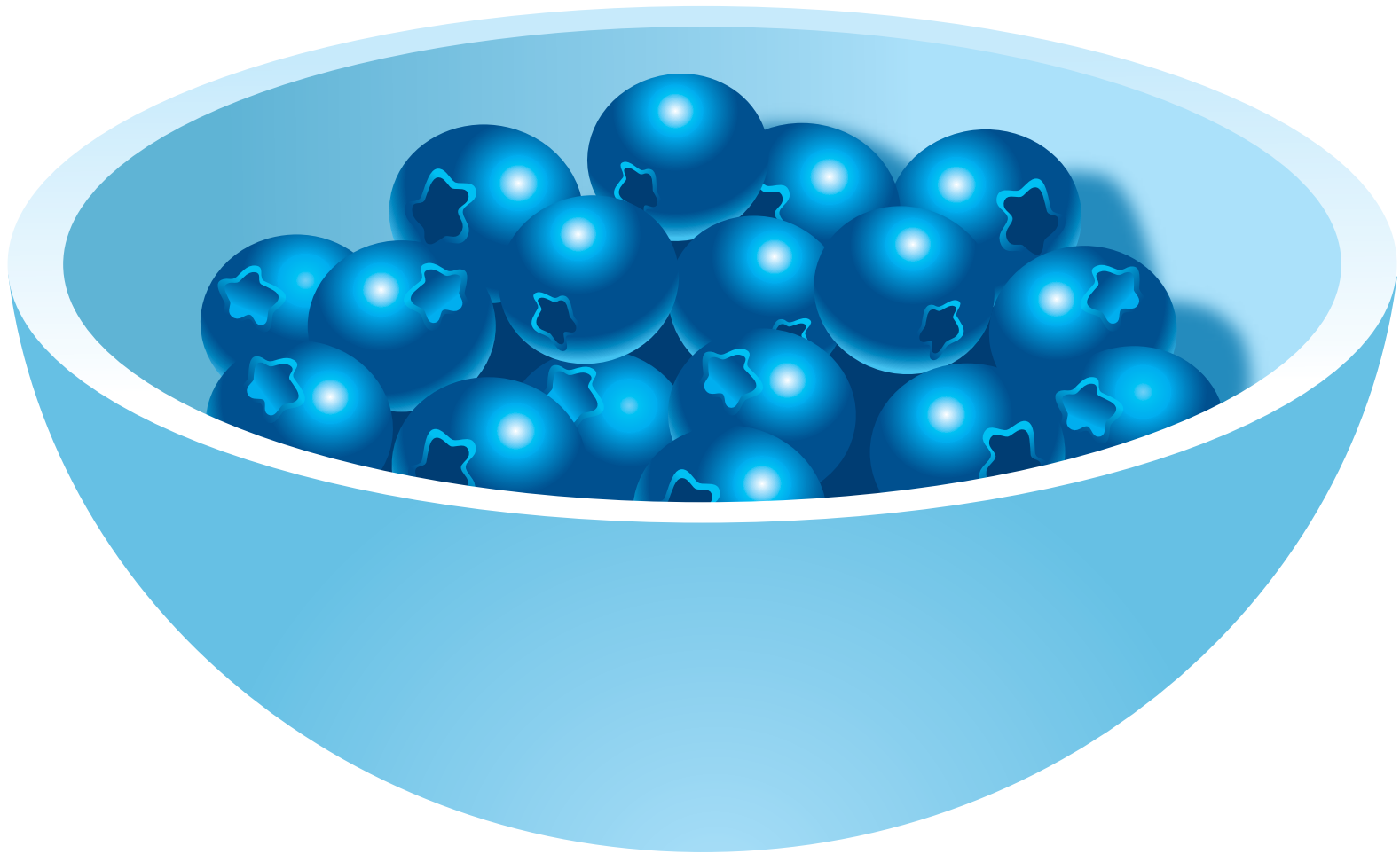
The orange is orange.



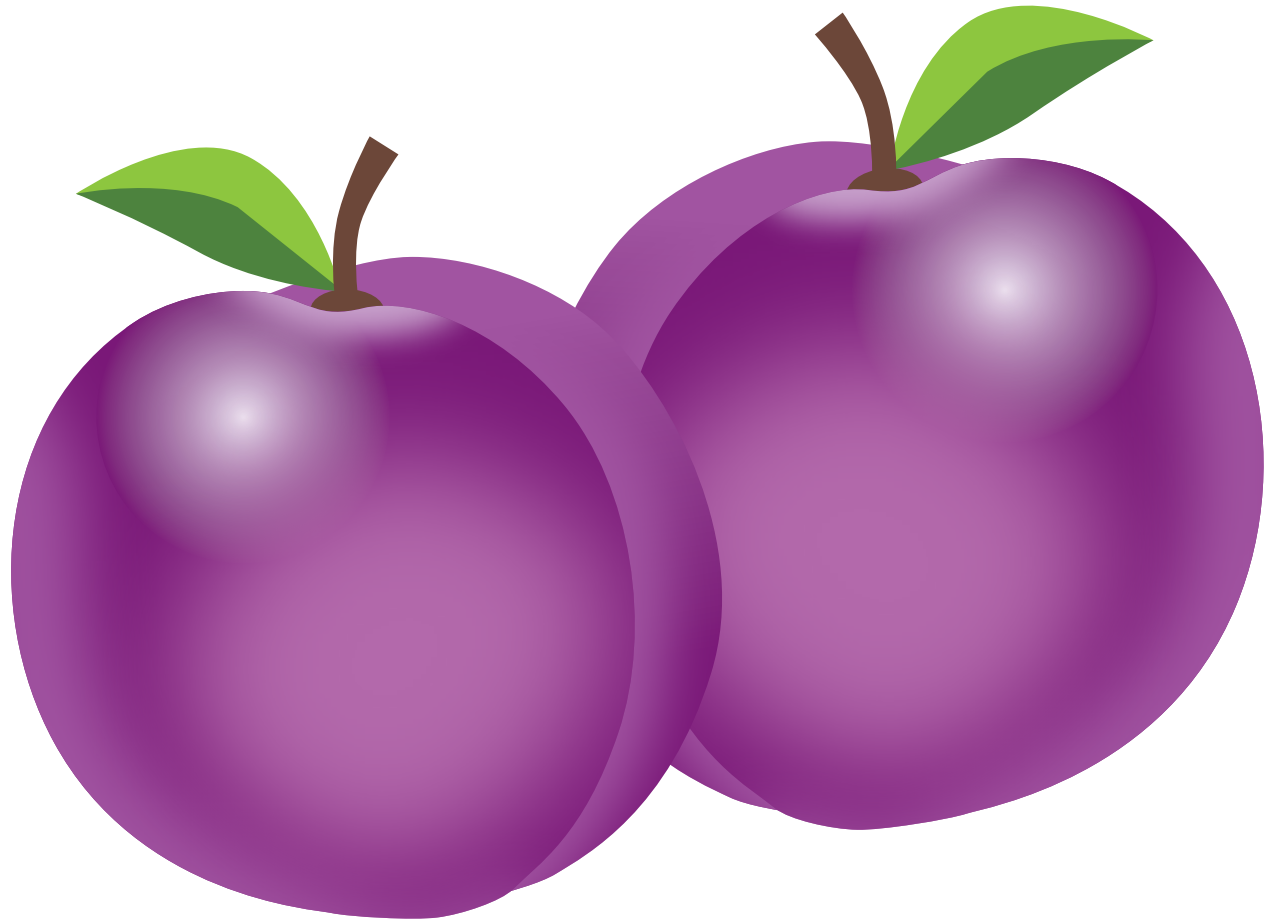
The pineapple is yellow.



The grapes are green.



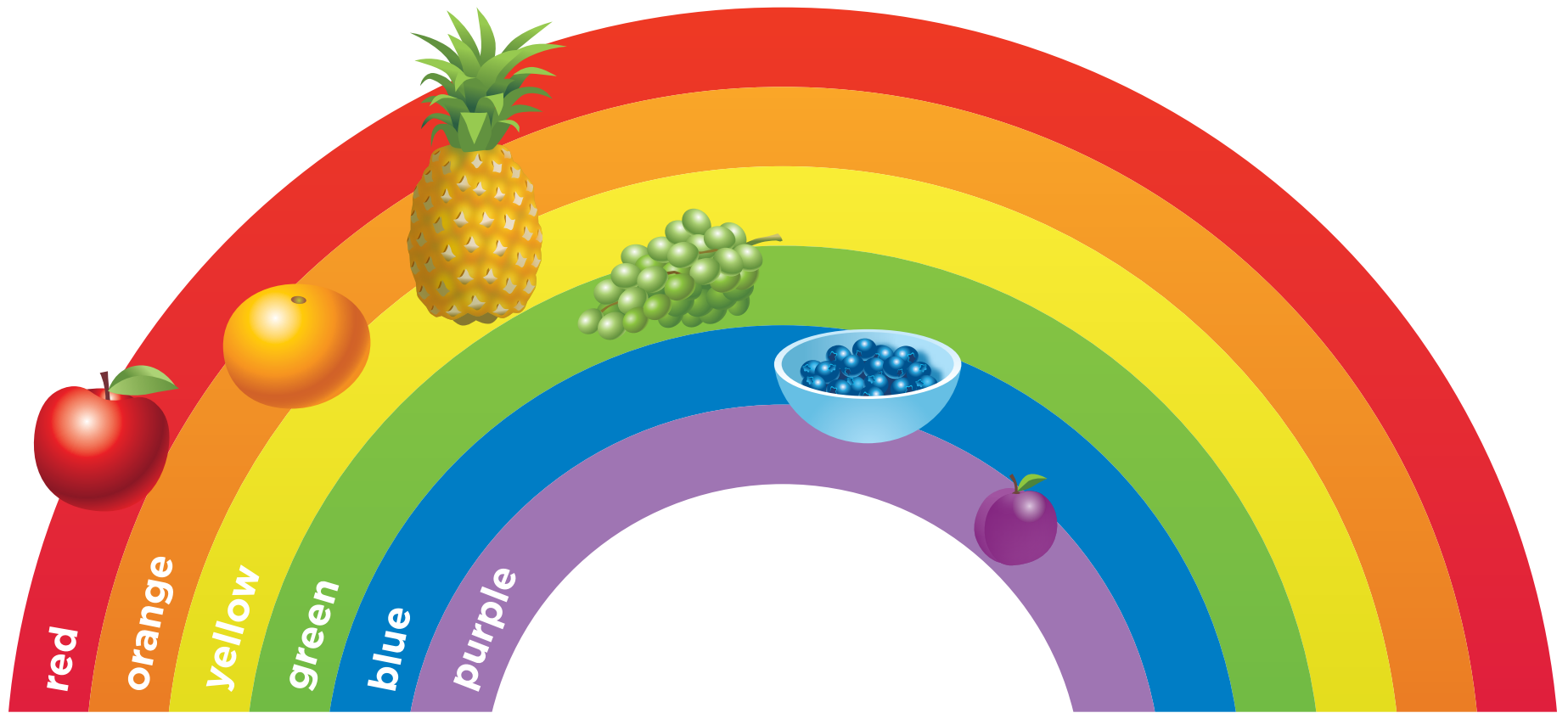
The berries are blue.
